2007 IN REVIEW

RSVP Volunteers demonstrating their commitment to community with another *record level* of services this past year, with **190,464** Hours of Service provided to **167** non-profit organizations, government departments and proprietary health care facilities. A conservative estimate of the value of these services is **\$1,900,000**. **99 New Volunteers** and **12 New stations** joined our efforts this past year.

Highlights of 2007 were:

- Participation in **40** speaking engagements and community events to publicize RSVP.
- Another successful Lunch and Silent Auction.
- **149** RSVP volunteers who served 400+ hours; were recognized at a special Top Volunteers luncheon.
- 249 Volunteers 75 years old/older were recognized at a special Birthday Celebration
- The average age of a RSVP volunteer is 76. 429 volunteers serve less than 260 hours annually. 4 serve over 1560 hours. 71% are female and 29% are male RSVP volunteers.
- Many thanks to **Regina Morris** as Chairperson. She was very active in helping with program advice, program evaluation, and assistance with the three Volunteer Recognition events. Vivian Smith has stepped up as chairman beginning July, 2007..
- **Liv Whiting**, after three years, has turned over the reigns to **Jim Funk**, who has assumed the chairman position on the Board of Directors beginning July, 2007
- Volunteer Coordinator **Willie Edwards** was elected President of the Virginia S.A.L.T. Council.
- Creating a RSVP Cookbook for both fun and fund-raising.
- Various recognitions, including Corporate and Community Partner of the Year Award from Insight Enterprises, Inc., The Center for Independent Living, Hampton Clean City Commission, and the Newport News Clean City Commission.
